Update of the Hurricanes Harvey & Irma Relief Projects

In the fall of 2017, a fundraising campaign was held by Camillian Disaster Service USA (CADIS USA) in partnership with St. Camillus Foundation and Pastoral Care Department of the Order of St. Camillus to aid the victims of the two devastating hurricanes in Texas and Florida.

The Board of Directors for CADIS USA has just approved two projects that will be funded through the money raised from the campaign:

- In Houston, Texas the funds will go to the San Jose Clinic which has been providing medical care to the victims in the Houston area for low or no fees. Many of their clients are uninsured and due to loss of wages after the Hurricane are unable to pay anything towards their care. The generous funds given will help San Jose Clinic to provide these individuals and families medical care as they continue to rebuild their lives.
- In Naples, Florida the funds will go to Pelican Community Center and Lutheran Church which has been coordinating and housing volunteer mission groups to help low-income and disabled residents in the area repair and rebuild their homes. The generous funds will provide building materials, tools, safety gear and meals for these mission volunteers. Five mission groups are scheduled to travel to Naples in the next 3 months.
