Brother Nels Memorial Thanksgiving Food Drive (November 13th - November 20th)

The Pastoral Care Department's Brother Nels Memorial Thanksgiving Food Drive starts Monday, November 13th and will run through Monday, November 20th. Brother Nels was a member of the Camillian Order who established this yearly Food Drive. This year's food donations will be made to the Silver Spring Neighborhood Center which serves more than 8,000 individuals and families each year through programs that help them reach self-sufficiency including their Food Pantry. In 2016-2017, they served just under 4,000 people, and they did see an increase in the number of children in families who receive emergency food services. They have also added a baby sanctuary to their services, so donations of diapers and formula are needed as well. If you would like to donate, please place your nonperishable items either on the designated table in the Atrium at San Camillo or in the box outside of Pastoral Care. **Please be aware that outdated or open food items cannot be accepted, so please check before donating.**
